- We reached out to Chelan County offering WASART assistance with their wildfire emergency shelter for livestock at the Chelan County Fairgrounds. At this time they do not need assistance.
 - Jeanette has been in contact with Animal Care & Control Sgt Chelsea
 Chanley who works for an LLC under Wenatchee Humane Society. She is interested in shelter training for her officers. They have a sheltering trailer with kennels and medical supplies for approximately 80 small animals.
- Annual Exercise (Oct 24-25) planning is ongoing with the intent to have the shelter stations all fully staged so that the trainees will spend the majority of time on intake and caring for the animals before demobing the shelter. Lunch will again be provided.

Link will be shared and all are encouraged to attend the review and stay for the rest of the meeting if they like.
